

# BROKERS/MANAGING BROKERS

## ONGOING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

All Indiana-licensed real estate Brokers must complete 12 hours of continuing education (CE) each year of the same 3-year license renewal cycle. *The exceptions are for Managing Brokers and Brokers newly licensed. See below.*

**Current License Renewal Cycle: July 1, 2020 — June 30, 2023**

**Brokers:** You will need to complete 36 hours of state-approved CE before renewing your license. That's 12 hours each year of this 3-year license renewal cycle.

**Managing Brokers:** You will need to complete 36 hours of state-approved CE before renewing your license. Additionally, 4 of the 12 hours of CE you complete each year must be state-approved Managing Broker curriculum.

Brokers and Managing Brokers who are members of the Indiana Association of REALTORS® receive a 12-hour online continuing education package each year at no additional cost.

The package comes from IAR's school, the **Real Estate Certification Program**, and fulfills both Broker and Managing Broker CE requirements from the state of Indiana.

**New Brokers:** You will need to complete a 30-hour state-approved Broker post-licensing course *within 2 years of your license issue date*. This course is required and satisfies your initial CE requirement during the first 2 years of licensure. See the chart below to know when you must start completing CE each year.

License Issue Date	30-Hour Post-Licensing Course Requirement	First Yearly 12-Hour CE Requirement
July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019	Within two years of license issue date	July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022
July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020	Within two years of license issue date	July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023
July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021	Within two years of license issue date	July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024
July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022	Within two years of license issue date	July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025
July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023	Within two years of license issue date	July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026

**Example:**

If I received my license 9/1/2020, I have two years to take my 30-hour Post-licensing course...

I need to begin the 30-hour Post-licensing course before 8/28/2022.

The first CE cycle will start 7/1/2022 in which I need 12 hours.

I must complete 12 hours of CE every year thereafter.
