

CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW LICENSEES

We want to clarify some confusion on C.E. requirements for newly licensed members.

Listed below are questions and answers that should help.

Question: What are the CE requirements?

Answer: Each year, July 1st through June 30th, twelve (12) hours of continuing education is required.

Question: What happens if I do not get all my CE hours by June 30th of any given year?

Answer: You are subject to an audit and if found to be in noncompliance you will be subject to a civil penalty of up to \$5000 and will be required to make up the deficient hours.

Question: I just received my license, do I need CE this year?

Answer: You are not required to complete the CE required before the following June 30th of the year you were licensed in. However, you are required to complete 30 hours of post licensure education within the next 2 years.

An individual issued a broker license after June 30, 2014 must, during the first two years after the license was issued, take and pass 30 hours of commission approved post licensing education. Completion of 30 hours of post licensing education as provided for in this rule fully satisfies any continuing education that otherwise would have been required.

Question: Where can I take the required 30 hours of CE?
